- 1. In July 2009, the Department of National Defence submitted a project proposal to the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) for the acquisition and installation of a containerized fuel system for use at CFS Alert.
- 2. On 23 October 2009, a Screening decision and Notice of Indication was provided to the Minister in accordance with 12.4.4 (a) of the Nunavut Land Claims Act advising that "the proposal may be processed without a review under part 5 or 6; NIRB may recommend specific terms and conditions to be attached to any approval, reflecting the primary objectives set out in Section 12.2.5".
- 3. Due to unforeseen circumstances, the contract for the procurement of the new tank system was cancelled. As a result of weather restrictions imposed on the delivery and installation of the tanks for CFS Alert, and the time required to retender the contract, completion of the project was not feasible.
- 4. Please accept this correspondence as a notice of termination for the project identified under NIRB File 09DN064.
