No impacts to water. The Ultra-Low Sulphur Diesel dispensing pump equipment was determined to be faulty. Spill site is located approximately 300 metres west of Dumbell Bay. Approx. 260 L were spilled where 230 L were recovered and disposed by incineration. Absorbent pads were deployed to collect fuel and placed into drums for incineration. Contamination of gravel resulted from spill. The spill site was continuously monitored by station personnel. Excavation of 49 cubic metres of contaminated gravel was conducted in Summer 2011 and placed into the landfarm facility for treatment. The concentration of fuel (F2 hydrocarbon fraction) in the excavated contaminated material entering the LandFarm Treatment Facility was 790 ug/g (ppm; see Appendix G). The faulty dispensing pump equipment was disconnected and entirely replaced with new equipment in Summer 2011. Filling of excavation site used fresh gravel from Alert Quarry.
