The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB" or "Board") has completed a technical review of 2012 Annual Report for the above mentioned project, which was submitted on February 28, 2013. The Report and attached submissions were distributed for information.

The annual report is found to be complete and meeting the reporting requirements of licence 3BC-ALT1015. In addition, the NWB appreciates the inclusion of the 2012 CFS Alert Constructed Wetland Assessment Report, and photographs to help aid in the understanding of the activities that have taken place.

The NWB notices that BOD<sub>5</sub>, Total Suspended Solids (TSS) and Oil Grease are reported to exceed the maximum allowable concentrations at ALT-3 Monitoring Station. The Licensee is advised to continue thoroughly assessing the performance of Sewage Terrace System (terrace wetland).
