Contained within the overall plan is the Hazardous Materials Management Plan, Spill Contingency Plan, and the QAQC plan. Every effort has been made to meet the requirements of an O&M plan as outlined in *Guidelines for the Preparation of an Operation and Maintenance Manual for Sewage and Solid Waste Disposal Facilities in the Northwest Territories*, and the licence itself. It is our understanding that this will be a living document, and may be subject to change based on the annual review process and the ability of the Station to meet the transportation requirements for the sampling program. Considering that CFS Alert is the most northerly, populated community on Earth, there are clearly numerous logistical challenges that will need to be met for the success of the plan.
