## RE: Amendment to NWB Water Licence 3BC-AWW0814

As previously indicated, following the success of the Winter Warfare Advance Course in March 2009, the Army is once again proposing to conduct, in March 2010, its annual Arctic Operations Advisor Course Session 7 (AOA) in the area of Resolute Bay, Cornwallis Island, Nunavut.
