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

During the conduct of the Arctic Operations Advisor (AOA) course, formerly known as the Winter Warfare Advanced (WWA) course, water is not drawn from the host community water bodies. Also, as stated in the AOA course description, waste water generated during the conduct of the AOA activities is frozen, and transported for disposal in Trenton, and not in host communities, after the conduct of the AOA training. Therefore the NWB Water licencing requirements is not applicable to the conduct of the AOA course.
