## Dear Alexandre Langlois:

Following the thirty day public comment period which ended on June 4, 2010, the NWB has received submissions from Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC), June 4, 2010; Environment Canada (EC), May 28, 2010 and Government of Nunavut – Department of Culture, Language, Elders and Youth (GN-CLEY), April 28, 2010. Please note comments raised by INAC and EC which pertain to the Spill Contingency Plan (SCP.

The NWB requests a resubmission or addendum to the SCP which addresses comments and concerns raised by the parties and issues as identified below by the NWB. The requested material will facilitate the technical review process and depending on a brief response time by the applicant, should hasten the overall application process. In addition to the comments received by the parties, in the SCP resubmission/addendum, the following deficiencies noted by the NWB are to be addressed:

- 1. Date plan was prepared and effective period;
- 2. On-site location of MSDS current of 3 years;
- 3. Number of spill kits including location, contents and absorbent capacity; and
- 4. Copy of the NT/NU Spill Report Form (available on NWB ftp site).
