Re: <u>3BC-BGI0813 - Cancellation Application - Belcher Glacier Ice Cap</u> Project, Devon Island - University of Alberta.

## Background

The Belcher Glacier Ice Cap Project is located on the Devon Ice Cap, Devon Island, in the Qikiqtani Region of Nunavut. The closest community is the Hamlet of Grise Fjord located approximately 120km to the North. During the spring field season facilities include 2-4 tents for sleeping, a cooking tent, equipment storage tent, snowmobiles, sleds and fuel supply areas.

## **Recommendations/Comments**

The applicant applied for and was granted water licence #8WLC-BGI1415, Approval for Use of Waters or Deposit of Waste Without a License to replace 3BC-BGI0813.

INAC therefore recommends the cancellation of water licence 3BC-BGI0813 since there are no non-compliance issues associated with this licence and all project components are now licenced under 8WLC-BGI1415.

However, INAC recommends that an inspection be carried out to ensure that all structures and facilities that was a part of water licence 3BC-BGI0813 are captured under the current licence 8WLC-BGI1415.
