Thanks for your email.

The assessment of the abandoned Project site by an INAC Inspector (a site final Inspection Report) is required; however, in order to cancel a water licence there are more requirements than that.

The first step in the water licence cancellation process is for the Licensee to submit a water licence application for cancellation. Upon receipt, the NWB performs an administrative review on the file to assess whether there is any issue pending.

Next, the NWB conducts a public review of the cancellation application by giving public notice of the application and inviting interested persons to make representations. After all parties, including INAC have provided their written conformity or no objection for the file to be cancelled, an INAC Final Inspection Report is requested. Finally, if there are not objections, the file is closed.
