Good Afternoon Phyllis,

I have advise Canadian Wildlife Service, Environment Canada to consult with the NWB regarding the Nunavut Water Regulations and there authorization 3BC-COA and 3BC-EAS.

In total EC is holing four licences for four research projects. Two of which are still 3BC licenses. The running list I have is 3BC-EAS1214 Eider/shorebird camp, 8WLC-AIL1415 Goose Camp, 8WLC-PSC1314 Coast Island Shorebird, and 3BC-COA0913 Coats seabirds.

I have recommended to EC they speaks with the NWB and apply for 8WLC licence for 3BC-COA and 3BC-EAS.

All the camps are very low impact to the environment, the operating season is short and the use of water and deposit of waste is far below the threshold. I also would fully support the closure of these files in place of the 8WLC.
