Dear Ms. LeMoine:

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") acknowledges receipt on April 13, 2011 of your new water license application for the Cape Sheridan Archaeology Project, file number 3BC-CSA----.

We undertook a preliminary administrative review of your application and conclude that, in accordance with approved legislation under the *Agreement Between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada* ("NLCA"), it does not contain sufficient information for the NWB to commence processing the file at this time. Specifically, we are asking you to provide the following:

- 1. Inuktitut Summary of the Project
- 2. Written Confirmation to whom the water licence will be issued (either under your name or the college or both?)
- 3. The Spill Plan should include the following:
 - a. Contingency measures to address different spill scenarios such as spill on land, water or ice;
 - b. A section pertaining to training;
 - e. A copy of NT-NU Spill Report Form; and
 - f. The contact numbers of the INAC Manager of Field Operations, GN-DOE, EC, DFO, Nunavut Spill Report Line and QIA.

We will resume processing your application once additional information has been received.
