A. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On May 2, 2013 the Nunavut Water Board provided notification to Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) that Genevieve LeMoine, on behalf of The Peary-MacMillan Arctic Museum, Bowdoin College had submitted an application for a Type B Water Licence Cancellation, No. 3BC-CSA1112. The submitted information is as follows:

1. Application for Water Licence Cancellation, dated April 13, 2013.
2. 2011 Summary Report, dated May 2, 2013.
3. E-Mail Cover Letter for Cancellation, dated April 3, 2013.

The Application for Water Licence Cancellation was received from the licensee on April 3, 2013. The Licence was issued on June 16, 2011 with the water to be used exclusively for camp purposes while the team of researchers carried out their archeological survey and mapping work.



Interested parties were requested to review the information and provide comments by June 2, 2013.

B. RESULTS OF REVIEW

On behalf of AANDC, the following comments/ recommendations are submitted to the Nunavut Water Board for consideration:

1. Application for Water Licence Cancellation Form

- AANDC finds the cancellation application complete and recommends that the above referenced license not be cancelled/ closed until a Water Resource Officer completes an on-site inspection and provides confirmation that no compliance issues are associated and/or remain outstanding with the project.
