There has been no alteration of the area. Extra fuel and waste have been removed from the location at the end of the last field season used under this permit (2010) and the sump hole filled. Use of the camp area by Grant Gilchrist and Michael Janssen will continue but the camp permits will be administered under the Nunavik Marine Region Impact Review Board for land and water use.

Unlike what is stated on our licence, this is NOT a mining operation. This was a research camp studying the nesting Akpa colony, so would fall under the classification of 'Conservation'.
