Since 2013 following the expiry of the issued License a number of attempts to contact you have been made with respect to the required reporting, annual fees and your intentions to continue any work in the area or to move toward the closure of the issued License.

The Field Operations Unit of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada is currently engaged in conducting our annual Risk Prioritization Exercise in preparation for the 2015 field season.
