Re: Water permit 3BC-ERI1011 Ellef Ringnes Island, Nunavut

Dear Mr Keim,

Please find attached two maps indicating our camp on Ellef Ringnes Island in 2010-2011 Latitude: 78° 13′ 14″ N Longitude: 101° 4′ 34″ W.

The camp occupied an area roughly 150 m x 200 m (3 Ha) and included 7 sleeping tents, a cook tent and an office tent.

The site had been previously occupied by Panarctic Oils. A portion of their Hercules landing strip was used by a Twin Otter to establish and remove the camp. A helicopter and fuel was stationed at the camp.

The field work consisted of geological mapping using helicopter. No roads, seismic lines or drilling was undertaken.

Water usage 2010:

- 4020 litres was used on Ellef Ringnes. The majority is from sea ice and the rest from Resolute
- There were 635 person days on the island 6.3 litres water/person/day on average.
- all garbage was shipped back to Resolute, we did not burn any on site.
- Total of 45 bags of garbage where shipped out.
- All grey water was disposed in sumps
- Human waste was disposed in pit toilets location 210 m from the nearest water body.
- Toilet paper was collected and burned on site.
- One spill of <2 litres engine oil occurred during helicopter maintenance. The sand the oil spilled on was collected in a rock pail (~15 kg) and shipped to Resolute for disposal.

Water usage 2011

The camp was occupied 11 July to 5 August 2011 by up to 14 people.

- 2450 litres was used on Ellef Ringnes. The majority is from sea ice and the rest from Resolute.
- There were 305 person days on the island, 8.0 litres water/person/day on average.
- All garbage was shipped back to Resolute, we did not burn any on site.
- Total of 25 bags of garbage where shipped to Resolute.
- All grey water was disposed in sumps
- Human waste was disposed in pit toilets location 210 m from the nearest water body.
- Toilet paper was collected and burned on site.
- No spills occurred.


