TITLE: Geology and hydrocarbon potential of Ellef Ringnes Island

OBJECTIVES OF RESEARCH:

The purpose of this project is to update our understanding of the geology and hydrocarbon potential of Ellef Ringnes Island. The island was last mapped in 1967. A detailed geological map of the island will be produced. This map will be used to help re-interpret the seismic data that was collected in the 1970s and 1980s. Field work will be from a temporary tent camp of about 20 people for one month, with a few days of setup and teardown at each end. Camp will be taken in to an existing airstrip using a Twin Otter. Transport on the island will be by Bell 205 helicopter supported by the Polar Continental Shelf Project.


