1. NPC Conformity or confirmation from NPC that the file does not require a conformity due to the fact that it is outside the boundaries of an approved land use planning area.
2. Screening Decision from NIRB or notification of exemption
3. Spill Contingency Plan
4. Remote Camp Supplemental Questionnaire (copy attached)
5. Administration fee and water use fee totaling \$60.00 (if paying by cheque please make payable to Receiver General for Canada)
6. Confirmation of research grant to proceed with the project (in lieu of financial statements)
7. Map of the project area
8. Confirmation of Project name as Helluland Archaeology Project
