Dear Brian Aglukark,
I forgot to attach the description and map to my earlier email, a copy of which follows:
I am an archaeologist with the Canadian Museum of Civilization. For several years I have been working at a site 25 km from Kimmirut on the south coast of Baffin Island, with the help of people from the community.
I plan to return this summer, and to establish a tent camp for seven people for five weeks in order to do the work. I attach a summary of the project in English and Inuktitut, and a map showing the location.

I have applied to QIA for the usual exemption for a land use permit. I have learned that I now also need a Nunavut Water Board Licence for this camp, and have applied for a licence. However they require confirmation from NPC that my camp does not require a conformity ruling. I understand that there is no Land Use Plan in place for South Baffin yet, so assume that this is not an issue.

I would be very appreciative if you could inform me by e-mail that no conformity is required.
