

Turaavik Outpost Camp Spill Contingency Plan

Turaavik Outpost Camp will be equipped with absorbent booms incase of oil or gasoline spills that might happen in the water. The camp will also be equipped with absorbent pads that might happen on land.

All employees will be trained in proper use of absorbency material. Employees will be trained in containing a spill and how to clean up a spill. The camp will have a operations report sheet located at the camp help in the reporting and recording process.

If a spill happens the products mentioned will be used, collected and placed in a industrial plastic bag. The land around the spill area will be collected onto a separate industrial plastic bag. The collected material will be doubled to insure no more spillage will happen.

All of the spill material will be transported to Baker Lake in a 200 L plastic storage container by either boat or snowmobile or ATV and handed to the hamlet of Baker Lake officials for proper disposal.

A detailed oil spill report will be put together containing the area of spill, how much spillage, what was spilled, steps taken to contain the spill and the steps taken to clean up the spill.
