The project involves camping at two sites, each occupied for approximately two weeks, with 6 to 7 people in camp. Therefore, each camp will see approximately 98 person days, or less, of occupation. I have applied for, or will apply for, a Nunavut Archaeology Permit, Inuit Land Use License, and Nunavut Water Board License, for these activities. The research is planned and carried out in cooperation with the Kitikmeot Heritage Society (KHS), an organization run by Inuit elders dedicated to researching, preserving, and interpreting heritage issues. I was in Cambridge Bay in December to plan these activities, and the KHS is very supportive of the proposed research.
