I estimated 2 -3 gallons of water use based on cooking and washing some dishes. We have always used bio degradable camp soap for cleaning our dishes and the gray water is just spilled on the ground. There would also be a minimum use for brushing teeth and washing. We also always identify a location close to camp that is used as a common toilet and all human waste and toilet paper is covered with flat rocks to contain it.
