Hello Ida,

The NIRB received the NPC Conformity for the Class B Water License on May 5, 2010. As this application is exempt from screening under 12-1 of the NLCA, the NIRB has not been triggered to conduct a new screening therefore the Screening Decision Report from April 9, 2010 is still effective.

However, I would also like to update you on the current status of this file. On February 9, 2010 the NIRB received a notice of amendment to Elizabeth Turner's NRI Application. A letter detailing the requirement for the amendment to have an NPC Conformity determination was sent to the proponent, with NRI and NPC on the cc list. Since February 9, 2010 the NIRB and NRI have tried to follow up several times to get a conformity including a re-circulation of the previously mentioned letter to the proponent, NPC, and NRI on May 17, 2010.

The NIRB is currently waiting for an NPC Conformity on Elizabeth Turner's NRI application to determine whether the research project will require a new screening or be eligible for a 12.4.3 amendment exempted from further screening decision.
