### **OBJECTIVES OF RESEARCH:**

This project's field activity is focussed on the origin of a set of 1.1 billion year-old dolostone rocks on northern Baffin Island. The dolostone was deposited in an ancient ocean during a time when Earth's crust in what is now eastern Nunavut was stretching and forming a low area filled by sea water, which spans what is now northern Baffin Island. These dolostone masses were deposited in deep water only where regional fractures in Earth's crust reached the sea floor; the fractures facilitated stretching and faulting of the crust and emitted fluids that promoted dolostone formation.
