Nunavut Water Board License No. 3BC-MIO0809 was obtained in 2008 for the purpose of carrying out archaeological fieldwork between July 16 and August 4, 2008 at archaeological site LdFa-1, which is situated at the northwest corner of Mingo Lake in the interior of southern Baffin Island. This was a one-time-only project, so there was no intention to return to the location or make use of water resources in subsequent years. The site has not been visited since August 4, 2008 and will not be visited again. This report therefore simply describes the fact that there was no use of the site in calendary year 2009.
