Fuel Spill Contingency Plan

Our remote fly camp will have no motorized equipment (no vehicles, no power tools, nothing that uses gasoline). We will not have a generator or any power supply other than a hand held solar charger. The only fuel in camp will be one 5 gallon propane tank used for cooking when attached to a 2 burner Coleman Stove.

Location: The tank will be located in the right front door of the main kitchen tent.

Spill prevention: The tank will be turned off at the source and its fuel line after each use. The tank will be kept separate from the stove and other equipment. The team will carry two extra fuel lines and an extra seal to make repairs should such equipment require it.

Spill Response: As propane is a gas, and we will only carry five gallons, the best remediation is through rapid ventilation of the local area to allow the gas to escape and enter the air without condensation into a liquid. The response procedure is aimed at such a rapid action including:

- 1. Propane gas has a distinctive smell and crew will be instructed to act fast when it is encountered. All windows and doors to the tent will be opened to allow rapid ventilation.
- 2. The first action is to make sure that the leak is not due to open valves on the, stove burner, fuel line or tank. These will be checked then secured if necessary.
- 3. If the leak remains the gaskets and seals will be checked by olfactory assessment. Seals will be repaired as necessary.
- **4.** Pending major leak, the tank will be removed from the tent allowing the gasses to be released to the air.

Polar Shelf RESOLUTE (867 252-3872) will be notified immediately in the case of #4 via satellite phone. Neil Shubin will report this directly.

POSTING: A laminated version of the above plan, with contacts will be posted prominently in our tent (a 10x10 foot nylon structure)




