Subject: Application for Water Licence – Paleozoid Vertebrates of Devon Island Project

Dear Mr. Shubin:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) acknowledges receipt of an application dated March 15, 2011 and received on March 25, 2011 for a Type B water licence for a research camp located on Devon Island. The Board requires a minimum of three months to process an application once it has been determined that the application is complete. Based on information provided there is insufficient time to fully process this application as indications are that the project will be commencing within the next couple of weeks and will not continue after July of this year. The NWB therefore cannot accept the application at this time and no licence will be issued.

To ensure adequate time for processing of any future applications, the NWB recommends that an application be submitted at least 90 days prior to any planned commencement of water use or deposition of waste requiring a water licence. If the water use and/or the deposition of waste are likely to extend over several years, the NWB also encourages applicants to apply for a multi-year term.

In closing, the NWB draws your attention to sections 11 and 12 of the NWNSRTA, which, subject to certain exceptions, prohibits the use of waters and deposition of waste in Nunavut except in accordance with the conditions of a licence.
