**Re: 'B' Class License Application – Camp Operations – Nuna M&T Services – 3BC-TEH**

In response to the comments and recommendations in the letter dated Nov. 6, 06 from Nunavut Department of Environment (Helen Yeh), I present the following information:

1. Spill Contingency Plan

- ❑ We do not intend to store fuel in drums, but if we do we will attempt to store them in a natural depression as suggested.
- ❑ Until the area is prepared for the camp, we cannot develop a site map. There will not be a fuel storage area as we do not intend to store bulk fuels at the site.
- ❑ The spill plan will be expanded when the camp is set up. The exact location of the spill kits will be included at that time.

2. Incineration

- ❑ The specification sheet for our incinerator is attached. The incinerator is new and meets all the standards that Ms. Yeh mentions. We do have a training program on the operation of the incinerator which will be presented to all operators prior to them operating the unit.
- ❑ All records will be maintained at the site for the maintenance and operation of the incinerator.

I trust that the above covers the comments from the Nunavut Department of Environment.
