On behalf of Environment Canada (EC), I have reviewed the information submitted with the above-mentioned application. The following specialist advice has been provided pursuant to the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act*, Section 36(3) of the *Fisheries Act*, the *Migratory Birds Convention Act*, and the *Species at Risk Act*.

Anne Hamilton, of the Department of Anthropology at the University of Manitoba, has submitted a Spill Contingency Plan as a condition of the issued water license 3BC-TUN0910. The water license is for the use of water during the operation of the research project at the Tungatsivvik site, Peterhead Inlet, Nunavut.

Environment Canada provides the following comments with respect to the Spill Contingency Plan:
