Re: Application Pending NPC Conformity Determination and Referral from an Authorizing Agency for Windfall Film's "Your Inner Fish" Project Proposal

Dear Kristina Obradovic:

The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Windfall Film's "Your Inner Fish" project proposal from the Nunavut Water Board on March 28, 2013. The project proposal submission included the following documents:

- *Nunavut Water Board General Water Licence Application*
- *Maps*

Your project appears to be located in an area which requires conformity to the North Baffin Regional Land Use Plan, pursuant to Article 11 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA). Please be advised that Proponents are required to submit their project proposals directly to the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) for a conformity determination. The NIRB conducts screening (environmental impact assessment) of project proposals upon referral from Government departments/agencies and Regional Inuit Associations responsible for authorizing the proposed project works or activities. Please be advised that it is the Proponent's responsibility to apply for all authorizations and approvals required to carry out the proposed project works or activities.

Once the NIRB receives a positive conformity determination from the NPC and a Referral from an authorizing agency, the Board will screen the project proposal in accordance with Article 12, Part 4 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement and will report to the Government Minister(s) responsible for authorizing the project.

Further, upon receipt of the required referral and conformity determination, the NIRB will be undertaking a preliminary completeness check of your application. In order to ensure your application contains the minimum information required for the NIRB's screening, it is

recommended that you submit the following, noting that the NIRB may request additional information at any point during the screening process:

- *NIRB Part 1 Summary Application Form in English*
- *NIRB Part 1 Summary Application Form in Inuktitut*
- *Non technical Project Proposal summary in English*
- *Non technical Project Proposal summary in Inuktitut*
