Sub: Renewal Water License Application of the Municipality of Arctic Bay

Dear Ms. Phyllis,

I am writing you to inform that the existing water License No: 3BM-ARC010 of the Municipality of Arctic Bay will be expired on March 31, 2010. During the life time of this licence, only wastewater treatment by Sewage Lagoon has been funded to upgrade. The new Sewage Lagoon is in construction phase and scheduled to commission in 2011. The existing facility will be decommissioned only after the new facility will be operational.

Using GAS TAX funding we are planning to build a new waste management facility, develop O&M manuals for all the environmental facilities and create a comprehensive compliance plan satisfying the requirements of the water licence. Currently we are in the planning process and expecting to implement and complete by 2012.

Therefore, I, on behalf of the Municipality of Arctic Bay, submit the water License application to renew for the period of five years. With this forwarding letter, the following documents are attached:
