I am writing you to inform that the existing Water Licence No: 3BM-ARC010 of the Municipality of Arctic Bay was expired on March 31, 2010. The Renewal application was submitted on March 01, 2010. Following the recent request of NWB dated February 18, 2014, Please see attached the renewal application in the new format in Appendix-A.

During the life time of the expired water licence, a new single cell sewage Lagoon was built and the old one was decommissioned under the amendment no.1 dated April 16, 2009. No modification was made to Water supply system and waste management site. The new lagoon has been operating for 2012 following the guidelines established in the Operation and Maintenance Manual prepared by the Consultant exp Services Inc. (ex name was Trow associates Ltd).

I request to disregard the previous application dated March15, 2010, and documentation submitted to support that application.

Please consider the present application in the new format and attached supporting documents as follows to renew the Water Licence # 3BM-ARC 0810.
