This project is exempt from screening by the Nunavut Planning Commission and by the Nunavut Impact Review Board.

I have been asked by the Board to inform you that a notice of your application is required. This notice of requirement is based on Article 13.3.14 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), which states that the Board should take “...all steps necessary by way of notice...to provide and promote public awareness [of hearings].”

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Accordingly, the enclosed notice in both English and Inuktitut will be posted for a period of 30 days, with the following establishments in Arctic Bay:- Hamlet Office, QIA, HTO, Northern Store, and Co-op Store.

Upon request from the public, we ask you to make available, free of charge, copies of all documents pertaining to this application. Any person who is affected by this application or concerned with it, may submit a letter of concern, which must be submitted to the Board within the period of time shown on the public notice.
