> Hi Philippe,
>
> As you are aware, the Minister has not yet responded to your letter of
> May 28, 2004, requesting consent under 55(5) of the Nunavut Waters and
> Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act for an Emergency Amendment for the
> Arctic Bay Water License. The availability of the Minister to address
> this matter, currently limited by the ongoing election and competing
> priorities such as Tahera, was not possible to obtain within a 10 day
> period.
>
> We recognize the urgency of the Arctic Bay sewage lagoon situation, and
> apologize that we were not able to obtain Ministerial approval for an
> Emergency Amendment. Under 55(4) the NWB is now free to take such
> action as it sees fit, and we trust that it will do so. The Minister
> will respond to NWB in due course.
