6. The DIAND Baffin District has been restructured and has been renamed the Nunavut District. Its boundaries mirror those of the Nunavut Land Claims Area. This has resulted in the communities of the Keewatin and Kitikmeot Regions being included in the Nunavut District. To this end, we will also be developing a similar database for these communities. It is our intention to provide this water quality information with the next annual update.
