Attention: Nunavut Water Board

On two occasions, I have forwarded to the Nunavut Water Board sketches and a description of work to be undertaken so as to ensure the integrity of the Sewage Lagoon in Arctic Bay. In general the works include additional fill on the berms, a slight increase in the height of the berms and addition of a "diversion berm" in the wetland.

These works were initiated in response to an urgent need. I visited the community in late April and concluded that the works were urgently required so as to prevent as much as possible, a failure of the lagoon system.

Therefore, with the understanding that the works were urgent in nature, I would request special consideration from the Nunavut Water Board (and other stakeholders) for approval of the works.

In addition, CGS will be undertaking an evaluation of the lagoon system in the summer of 2004 to determine long term measures to ensure an adequate sewage disposal system in the community.
