In response to the letter of Mr. David Hohnstein, C.E.T, Director Technical Services, dated November 27, 2012, I am submitting the following documents which are self-explanatory:

1. Final O&M Manual: one Hard copy and one CD
2. As built drawing of the old Lagoon which was decommissioned in 2012
3. Consultant's letter dated October 1, 2012 regarding geothermal modeling on the old lagoon (submitted)
4. Annual Reports for 2011 and 2012 (submitted)
5. Guidelines for extended sampling and testing Program to satisfy Part H of Water License

Hamlet is operating the New Sewage Lagoon under the guidelines of the attached O&M manual.

CGS is running a consultation and training exercise with the Hamlet SAO and Foreman on annual reporting, extended sampling and testing program on water, wastewater and leachate samples using the accredited lab "Caduceon Environmental Laboratories" located in Ottawa.

The lab test results of each year will be submitted along with the annual report in the following year by March 31 as per the guidelines of Part B of the Hamlet Water License.

The Solid waste project is currently on hold until further notice. Once this project is funded, the new solid waste facility will accommodate hazardous wastes in a containment cell within its boundary.

Spill contingency plan is included in Appendix B of the attached O&M manual.

CGS Technical staff will conduct annual summer inspection to this facility and include the findings in the annual report.

The Hamlet water license expired on March 31, 2010.
