Dear Mr. Van Horne:

The Nunavut Water Board acknowledges receipt on September 2, 2003 of your water license application, for the Municipality of Arviat. Your application included the following items:

- cover letter dated August 26, 2003
- project summary in English AND Inuktitut
- application form
- supplementary questionnaire
- Maps and diagrams
- Application fee

This project is currently being reviewed by various governing agencies for their determination as to whether they require further review, or if it can be processed by the Nunavut Water Board.

I have been asked by the Board to inform you that a <u>notice of your application is required</u>. This notice of requirement is based on Article 13.3.14 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), which states that the Board should take "...all steps necessary by way of notice...to provide and promote public awareness [of hearings]."

Accordingly, the attached notice, in both English and Inuktitut, will be posted for a period of 30 days, with local establishments in Arviat.

Upon request from the public, we ask you to make available, free of charge, copies of all documents pertaining to this application. Any person who is affected by this application or concerned with it, may submit a letter of concern, which must be submitted to the Board within the period of time shown on the public notice.
