RE: Pre-emptive Action Arviat Sewage Lagoon

With the slow arrival of both spring and summer this year accompanied with lower than normal seasonal temperatures, we are finding that the thawing of the permafrost layer in the sewage lagoon is well behind schedule. This has resulted in our lagoon not draining through the berm walls as part of the ex-filtration process, meaning that the lagoon has a much higher than normal level of effluent.

As of today we have 60cm of freeboard in the cell and we are concerned that if the temperatures do not improve significantly, coupled with rainfall that we could be in an overflow or breach position. We estimate that we dump approximately 5,000 to 7,000 M3 per month into the lagoon and that the total remaining capacity is estimated at 13,800 M3.

We are recommending that we immediately begin lowering the effluent level in the lagoon by mechanically pumping the effluent over the berm onto the normal ex-filtration drainage area on the south side of the lagoon.

Although Arviat is, at this time, an unlicensed water user we are advising you of our plan to drain the cell and we seek your concurrence with this course of action.

Our lagoon was inspected today by Constantine Bodykevich of INAC and he shares our concerns and concurs with our plan of action.
