

- A) Surveillance Network Program
 - 1. Find attached Analytical results from Samples collected at site1191-1 and 1191-2 and 1191-3
- B.) Monthly and Annual Quantities of water
 - 1. Find attached YTD water Consumption Bar graph for water consumption January 1/1998 to Dec 31/1998
- C.) Monthly and Annual Quantities of fluid discharge
 - Find attached YTD sewage fluid discharge from Jan 01/1998 to December31/1998
- D.) Modifications and maintenance Water Supply and Waste Disposal
 - 1. Water supply:
 - 1.1 Major modifications were carried out on the water take line, install intake line and pumps, controls etc (as per specs sent to Nunavut Water Board).
 - 1.2 Regular Maintenance performed on Pump House, utilidor storage tank removed, truck fill tanks emptied and cleaned. Regular p/m's of furnace and controls. Regular p/m on pumps and controls.

- 2. Sewage Disposal site:
- 2.1 No modifications were carried out for 1998 at the sewage disposal site.

3. Solid Waste Site:

- 2.2 Install chain link fence on the east and north side of waste site. Expand bulky waste site by 35m x 25m.
- 2.3 Compress drums barrels in drum crusher and stacked.
- 2.4 Signs erected to separate steel, tires, hazard (open tank)appliances
- 2.5 Bulky waste rearranged and organized
- 2.6 Honey bag cell decommissioned.
- 4. Abandonment and restoration work:
- 4.1 Airplane lake disposal project was continued; crush drums and buried, bulky waste site piled up in one place, major waste site from 1950's and 1960's buried. No funding provided.
- E: Unauthorized discharges:
- 1. There were no unauthorized discharges.
