The Nunavut Water Board would like to follow-up on the document you prepared titled, "Standards for Solid Waste: Operations and Maintenance" November 1996. The NWB would like to apologize for the delay in responding to this document and appreciate you bringing it to my attention at the public meeting on August 21, 1997.

Prior to performing a broad review of the O&M standards the NWB has identified areas which require clarification.
