## Hamlet of Cambridge Bay Clarification of Soil Landfarm Treatment Facility

Prepared by: Earth Tech (Canada) Inc. 17203–103<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Edmonton, AB T5S 1J4 In order to renew the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay's water licence from the Nunavut Water Board, the Hamlet is required to provide clarification regarding the proposed remedial objective for, and post-remedial usage of, any hydrocarbon-impacted soils to be treated in the hydrocarbon-impacted landfarm.

This clarification request was motivated in 2005 due to the presence of an excavation pit intended by a private citizen for the disposal of hydrocarbons.

This pit was excavated in the vicinity of the Hamlet's waste sites. However, this was not sanctioned in any way by the Hamlet. Following the excavation of the pit, the private corporation was prohibited from the dumping of any hydrocarbon-impacted waste in the pit or the vicinity of the Hamlet's waste sites.

As such, there is no record or history of any hydrocarbon-impacted soils or landfarm in the vicinity of the Hamlets waste site. Thus, no remedial objective or post-remedial usage of hydrocarbon-impacted soils is applicable.
