Deposit of Waste in Contravention of Water License – Type “B”

- Inspector's Direction -

I, Andrew Keim; duly designated Inspector pursuant to subsection 85 (1) of the ***Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act (2002 c.10)***, conducted, on July 4th, 2008 an Inspection of the Municipality of Cambridge Bay in the Kitikmeot Region Nunavut, Canada. This inspection was complete as part of the annual compliance assessment of the Municipal facilities and infrastructure within the community of Cambridge Bay.

This inspection was conducted to determine compliance with the *Nunavut Water and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunals Act* and specifically compliance with the currently expired Water License issued to the Municipality of Cambridge Bay, Nunavut.

As stipulated in subsection 12 1(b) of the Act. Except in accordance with the conditions of a License, no person shall deposit or permit the deposit of waste in any other place in Nunavut under conditions in which the waste, or any waste that results from the deposit of that waste, may enter waters in Nunavut.

During the period of Inspection it was determined through visual inspection that the Municipality of Cambridge Bay is in contravention of subsection 12 1 (b) of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*.

By copy of this Order and under the authority vested in me pursuant to subsection 87 (1) (ii) of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*, the Municipality of Cambridge Bay is directed as follows;

- To complete, to the satisfaction of the Inspector, the installation (including erection of) a fence that will encompass and surround the Municipal Waste Management area by November 30th 2008.
- To develop and submit to the Nunavut Water Board and the Kitikmeot Water Resources Officer (Inspector) within 90 days of receipt of this Direction, a comprehensive plan to address deficiencies with the Cambridge Bay Sewage Treatment area including the immediate and



surrounding areas and seepages as noted in previous reports and during the inspection with Hamlet Officials.

Failure to comply fully or in part with an **Inspector's Direction** constitutes a offence under subsection 90 (1) of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act* and entails, upon summary conviction, a fine of \$100,000 or to imprisonment for a term of one year, or both.

Further pursuant to subsection 90 (4) of the *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*, each day on which the **Inspector's Direction** is not complied with shall be considered a separate offence.
