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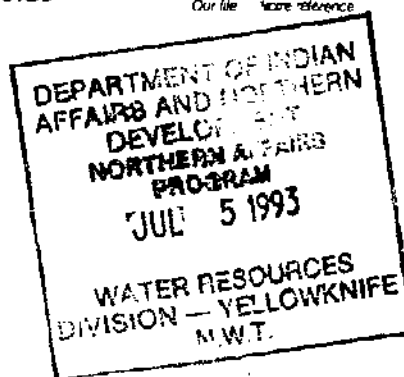

Plans and drawings of the existing water supply facilities are to be submitted immediately.

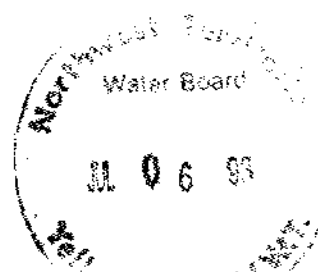
The Hamlet's efforts to comply with the requirements of their Water Licence are appreciated.

INTRODUCTION

This report covers the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay's compliance with their Water Licence N4L4-1532 for the 1992 Calendar year.

The Hamlet's Water Licence N4L4-1532 became effective July 1, 1988 and expires June 30, 1995.

INSPECTIONS

An inspection was conducted by Scott Gallupe, Water Resources Officer, Inuvik, on August 18, 1992. The contact people were Randy Bergen, Senior Administrative Officer and David Crocket, DPW Foreman.

WATER LICENCE N4L4-1532 1992 COMPLIANCE REVIEW

1. Part A: General Conditions

Item 3 states: "The Licensee shall file a report pursuant to Section 12(1) of the Act and Section 15(1) of the Regulations not later than March 1st of the year following the calendar year reported which shall contain the following information: ..." Please refer to the Licence.

Violation: The 1992 Annual Report was received May 25, 1993. Almost three (3) months late.

Item 9 states: "The Licensee shall within sixty (60) days of the issuance of this Licence, submit to the Board plans and drawings of the existing water supply and waste disposal facilities."

Violation: The Hamlet has never submitted plans nor drawings of the existing water supply.

Comment: The Hamlet submitted plans and drawings for the existing waste disposal facilities, however they were received May 22, 1991, almost three (3) years late.

2. Part B: Conditions Applying to Water Use

No violations are noted under this section for the 1992 calendar year.

3. Part C: Conditions Applying to Waste Disposal

Comment: There are no units for bagged sewage serviced by the Hamlet of Cambridge Bay. Subsequently, there is no bagged sewage pit at the solid waste disposal site.

4. Part D: Conditions Applying to Modifications

No violations are noted under this section for the 1992 calendar year.

No violations are noted under this section for the 1992 calendar year.


C. Reports
