**RE: NWB3CAM – Hamlet of Cambridge Bay - Pipeline Replacement**

On behalf of Environment Canada (EC), I have reviewed the information submitted with the above-mentioned application. The following specialist advice has been provided pursuant to Environment Canada's mandated responsibilities for the enforcement of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act*, Section 36(3) of the *Fisheries Act*, the *Migratory Birds Convention Act*, and the *Species at Risk Act*.

The Hamlet of Cambridge Bay has provided notification to the NWB of their upcoming pipeline replacement project, as required under Part E, Item 1 of their water license.

Environment Canada recommends that the following conditions be applied throughout all stages of the project:

- The proponent shall not deposit, nor permit the deposit of any fuel, chemicals, wastes or sediment into any water body. According to the Fisheries Act, Section 36(3), the deposition of deleterious substances of any type in water frequented by fish, or in any place under any conditions where the deleterious substance, or any other deleterious substance that results from the deposit of the deleterious substance, may enter any such water, is prohibited.
- Silt curtains, or other similar preventative measures, should be used when digging or trenching near waterbodies. The proponent must take measures to prevent the sedimentation of any surrounding waterbodies.
- All spills must be documented and reported to the NWT 24-hour Spill Line at (867) 920-8130.

If there are any changes in the proposed project, EC should be notified, as further review may be necessary.
