**STATUS OF MUNICIPAL WATER LICENCE APPLICATIONS**

This is in response to your memo of December 14, 1995 regarding the subject matter. I understand your frustration. I hope the following will clarify the status of these applications for you.

As you know the *Northwest Territories Waters Regulations* require that an application for a water licence include a plan of the municipality and of the water and sewage systems. The Water Board has made it clear that they do not wish to proceed without having received these documents.

We have received a plan of the municipality and of the truckfill station for Pond Inlet. We have not received any drawings for the waste disposal facilities. The drawings of the waste disposal facilities for Cape Dorset have been received. We have not, however, received their water supply drawings or a plan of the municipality. The application for Taloyoak did not include any drawings whatsoever.

In each of the above cases we have asked for the additional drawings. Until they are received we will not be able to proceed. If your office can provide any assistance in this regard it would be appreciated.

In the case of Arviat a final draft report on the effluent quality study was submitted to the Board at its December 13 meeting. It is currently being revised further. Once these revisions are completed we will proceed with licencing.

I hope this addresses your concerns. Please call me if you have any questions.
