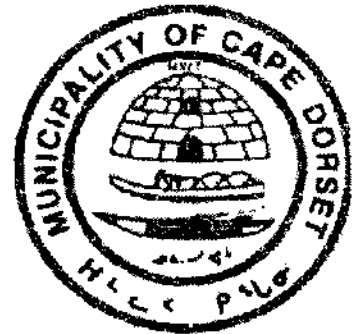

Re: Response to Intervener questions

I am in receipt of your letter sent via email dated May 8, 2006. The letter states that NWB requests a set of detailed responses to intervener comments submitted by Environment Canada, Indian & Northern Affairs Canada, Government of Nunavut – Dept. of Environment and Claude Constantineau.

By way of Motion #52/06-07 the Hamlet of Cape Dorset has authorized Dillon Consulting to respond to the Water Board on our behalf as they have the technical knowledge, expertise and experience to properly answer the concerns.

Furthermore, as you might be aware Dept. of Community and Government Services, Government of Nunavut (GN CGS) implements GN funded infrastructure projects in the municipalities. Dillon Consulting was recruited by GN-CGS as an engineering consultant for planning, design and contract administration of the P Lake Sewage Lagoon project under discussion. Primarily Dillon Consulting and also the representatives of GN-CGS will be communicating with the water board on behalf of Hamlet of Cape Dorset in respect of the sewage lagoon project as required to facilitate the successful implementation of the project.
