Sub: Water Licence renewal application of the Hamlet of Cape Dorset

Dear Phyllis,

I am writing you for the Water Licence renewal application of the Hamlet of Cape Dorset. The Current Water License # 3BM-CAP 0810 of the Hamlet of Cape Dorset will be expired on March 01, 2010. This Licence was issued in 2008 with some preconditions for commissioning the new Sewage Lagoon at P Lake built in 2007.

Four thermistors have been installed to satisfy the conditions of this Water Licence. An annual temperature data have been collected. AMEC, a Geotechnical Consultant, has been hired to validate the temperature data obtained from the field in 2008 and 2009. The Consultant is also working on the design and development of Technical Specifications of the monitoring wells at the New P Lake Sewage Lagoon, Metal dump site and Landfills site. These wells will be constructed during this summer 2010 and monitored satisfying the guidelines of this Water Licence.

Following the consultation with NWB, the O&M manual of the new Sewage Lagoon at P Lake has been revised in 2009 to satisfy the conditions of the existing Water Licence.

Concentric, an environmental consultant conducted a study on the metal wastes disposal site of the community in 2009.
