I am writing you to confirm that all the four thermistors in the New Sewage Lagoon of Cape Dorset are fully active. We have recently collected the filed data which is attached and self- explanatory.

I also confirm that monitoring wells at CAP-16, CAP-17 and CAP-18 were installed and equipment is available to extract ground water from the pipe as necessary.

The Sewage Lagoon berm is leaking almost at the middle. We are investigating the reason and planning to repair the berm in order to commission.

I will appreciate if you consider this information to expedite to renew the Hamlet Water Licence as early as possible.
