Dear Mr. Kharatyan,

We are submitting an Amendment and Renewal Water Licence application of the Hamlet of Cape Dorset excluding P lake Sewage Lagoon. Community and Government Services is still exploring options for the most appropriate long term solution to bring this sewage lagoon into compliance.

Dalhousie University is conducting a study to determine the wetland's treatment capacity this summer. This study will inform if/what upgrades are required to the lagoon. Following the outcome of this study, the next step will be taken.

Therefore, I am writing you to confirm to void all the Water licence # 3BM-CAP 0810 renewal applications submitted previously for the Hamlet of Cape Dorset because we are excluding the P lake sewage lagoon from the current renewal application.

Therefore, to renew and amend the existing Water Licence #3BM- CAP 0810, the following documents are attached for consideration:
