STATUS: 218-23⁶: Pond Inlet - screening - no change -nothing initiated pending receipt of information for licensing. 1638

218-23₄: Cape Dorset- same as above (unless B. Collins has gone ahead) 1643

218-23_i: Fort Resolution - this keeps cropping up re screening. Screening for the waste disposal site was signed off by the Board in Feb. 1995, and Land Admin. screened the reserve application in Nov. 1994. No further screening is planned. Fort Resolution

218-23_i: BHP culverts and road; not being screened by us. I gather that this part of the project has been cancelled? Anyway, you know what's currently going on.

218-23^m: J. Rocher marina : no changes or further approvals from anyone that I'm aware of. Apparently there was a meeting here a few weeks back, which included Coast Guard. R. Watkins is in YK the week of July 17, re this, the causeway and other matters. Nothing has changed re water licence. Apparently Lands may try and initiate transfer of the lots to GNWT (Commissioner's land) and then GNWT would transfer the land to the City.. 1630

218-23₄: Broughton Island: screening: I haven't seen the application/file yet, but Brian Collins noted that there likely isn't enough information to start licensing; so screening will follow whatever course the TAC process takes. 0640
